




VHYMC Scholarship Program

Although much of our volunteer work has been curtailed this year, VHYMC continues to support our local students by helping to fund their education. Our scholarship awards will total \$17,000 for 2020.



In November 2020, VHYMC agreed to fund two \$1000 scholarships to Nicolet College students through the Nicolet College Foundation.

The Dr. Henry Ashe Continuing Education Scholarship is being awarded to six college students who are pursuing degrees in medically related fields. Four of the recipients are undergraduates and two are graduate students. This is the first year that this \$2000 scholarship has been made available to graduate students.
